¹⁷This news about Jesus spread through all the places around there.

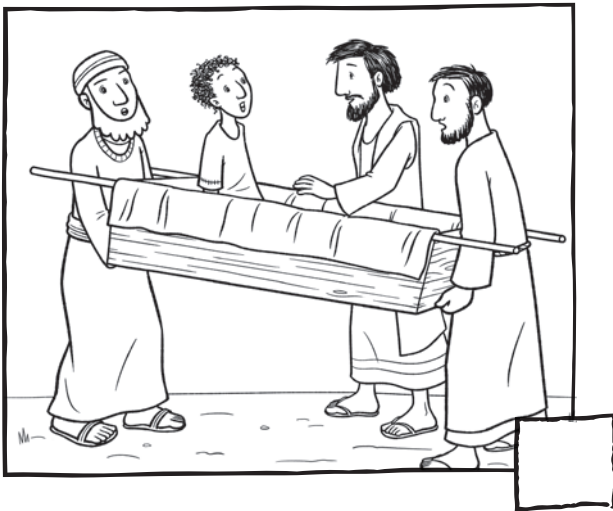
This is a paraphrased, simplified version of the Bible.

This is how they looked at the start of the story.

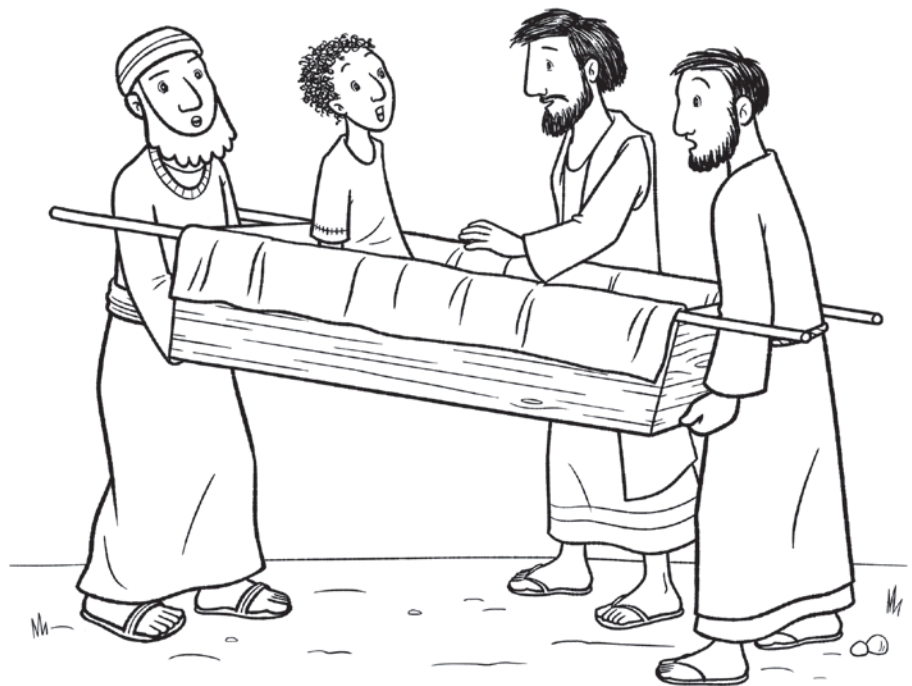
Why do they all look so sad?

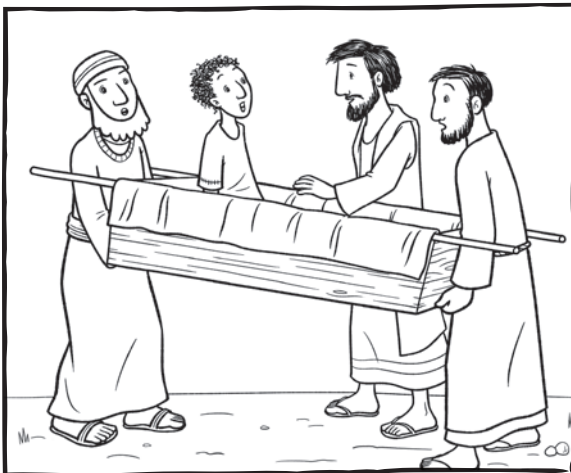
