## Jesus Heals a Paralytic

**LUKE 5:17-26** 

<sup>17</sup>One day Jesus was teaching the people. The Pharisees and teachers of the law were there, too. People had come from every part of the country. Jesus had the power to heal people

<sup>18</sup>There was a man who couldn't walk or use his legs. Some men were carrying him on a mat. They tried to bring him in and put him down by Jesus. <sup>19</sup>But because there were so many people there, they could not get close to Jesus. So the men went up on the roof and made a hole in the ceiling. They lowered the mat so that the paralysed man was lying right in front of Jesus. <sup>20</sup>Jesus saw that these men were sure that he would be able to heal their friend. So Jesus said to the paralysed man, "Friend, your sins are forgiven."

<sup>21</sup>The Jewish teachers of the law and the Pharisees thought to themselves, "Who is this man? He is saying things that are against God! Only God can forgive sins."

<sup>22</sup>But Jesus knew what they were thinking. He said, "Why are you thinking these things? <sup>23</sup>Which is easier: to tell this man, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to tell him, 'Stand up and walk'? <sup>24</sup>I will prove to you that I can forgive sins." So Jesus said to the man who couldn't walk, "I tell you, stand up! Take your mat and go home."









## Can you put these pictures in the right order? Do you remember what happened in the story?

Secondly, draw in the man's face to show how he feels about Jesus forgiving him for everything he has ever done wrong.






The Religious Leaders said that only God can forgive everything we've ever done wrong. They were right!






