

Secret Agents Holiday Club

This is a sketch that can be performed in church a month or more before Secret Agents Academy to engage the whole family with the purpose and their role. Follow it with a brief notice explaining the next steps.

Aim: Secret Agents Academy is the perfect opportunity for

- Terrific fun with friends
- Explaining the Good News about Jesus to those who haven't heard it

Bill & Ted walk on from different sides, dark glasses, school caps and "B" and "T" T-shirts.

Bill stands behind the lectern, Ted, stands next to him facing backwards.

Bill: Good morning, I'm Bill, and this is my brother Ted and we're...

Ted: Interrupting ...we're here because it's almost that time again. We're on

our way to the Secret Agent Academy and I'm so excited I might...

Bill: Heavily nudging Ted, through gritted teeth Ted, they're over here.

Ted: I'm on a roll. Don't stop me now.

Bill: I know... You're talking to a wall.

Ted: Ted raises dark glasses and discovers the wall. Looks over his shoulder,

and sees the people. Tries to turn round casually, as if he always meant

to face the wrong way.

That's all part of my Secret Agent training. Do you see what I did there?

That's an old trick to throw the enemy off the scent. I face that way, but

talk this way, and everyone thinks, that I'm talking to...

Bill: A wall? Everyone thinks you're talking to a wall. How does that help? Oh

Ted, come on, tell them about the Secret Agents Academy.

Ted: Yes, that's right. Ooh. Secret Agents Academy. It's terrific, couldn't be

better. Just really, really come. Lots of you. All together. All at the same

time. We'll laugh until we fall over. Here. Soon. Brilliant.

Bill: Tell them something useful.

Ted: Serious face. Real bears look like giant teddy bears, but they're actually

really dangerous, so don't ever try to hug them... unless they come to

you for a hug,... then it's probably fine....Is that right?

Bill: Exasperated Bill! Something useful about the Secret Agents Academy!

Ted: Yes, absolutely. *Pause*.

Bill: It's [give dates and location]

Ted: Quickfire from here And Sunday [date] is a special, Holiday Club

jamboree service.

Bill: [Times and days of the week]

Ted: Back home for lunch.

Bill: We'll be making stuff

Ted: And running around

Bill: Laughing...

Ted: ...and Crying

Bill: There's no crying.

Ted: Oh.

Bill: And in particular, remember, the reason we run the Academy is so that

we can invite our friends. It's all the help we need so that they hear

about Jesus. Perhaps for the first time.

Ted: Why would we want help telling our friends about Jesus?

Bill: slow down again Ted, what would you say to Bobby Biggins if he asked

you about Jesus?

Ted: I'd simply say... "Jesus is great"

Bill: And out of interest, what would you say, if Bobby Biggins asked you

about doughnuts?

Ted: I'd simply say... "doughnuts are great"

Bill: Do you see the problem Ted? Bobby Biggins won't know the difference

between doughnuts and Jesus.

Ted: Pause. That's deep.

Bill: No, it's not Ted. You need some help explaining how great Jesus is to

Bobby Biggins. He should come as well. Invite him.

Ted: Bobby Biggins can come? Here. Secret Agents Academy. Wow. He'll love

it. He got excited about his whoopee cushion. Imagine what he'll think of

Secret Agents Academy. Slow I think he'll burst.

Bill: Tell them about being Secret Agents, Ted

Ted: Whispers into microphone As secret agents, we'll be going deep

undercover, we'll be so deep, we'll need a ladder to get out. We're going to be uncovering the truth about Jesus, from Luke's Gospel. The truth is out there. If you want to come, get your application form in, get one to

Bobby Biggins... and your <u>own</u> friends. Don't hang around. It'll sell out.

Bill: And we need Leaders. The more leaders we have, the more children we

can take. No previous experience needed. We'll take great care of you.

Well, we won't, but someone will.

Ted: So that's everyone. We can all do Secret Agents Academy. Kids and

Adults? Something for everyone!
