

You will need...

- Board created at “God made the world” session with 5 pieces of material to stick up: Black, white, light blue for sky, light blue for water and green/brown for land.
- Helper
- Blindfold
- Kids trolley full of food
- Visual with splodges of lots of different colours

The story

Story	Actions
<p>This term we're in the very first page of the Bible</p> <p>We're finding out what happened in the very beginning. We've been finding out every week that God made everything.</p>	<p>Hold up Bible open at Genesis 1</p>
<p>Last week we saw that God made the night and the day, and he put the sky there with fluffy clouds, and then he made the land and the sea. He all this just by speaking.</p>	<p>Use board from “God made the world” session</p>
<p>I've got a friend to help me today. Introduce friend. I'm going to blindfold her.</p>	<p>Blindfold...</p>
<p>And here I've got my shopping trolley full of food</p>	
<p>Now this week we're going to find out that God made all the food we eat. And do you know that God made our fruit with so many different colours?</p>	<p>Hold up a visual with splodges of lots of different colours.</p>



God made food in every possible colour. Today we're going to see some fruit in each of these colours.
I'm going to give my helper (helper's name) a piece of fruit for each of these colours and she's going to tell us what they taste like.
So let's start.

For each piece of fruit follow through the following:
Point to a colour and announce the colour
Perhaps ask if they can think of a fruit that colour.
Reveal fruit from basket, and give name
Give a piece of fruit to friend
Ask "what does it taste like?"
For each fruit he/she needs to give child friendly words: squishy, juicy, bobbly, sweet, etc
Give fruit to friend in a variety of ways: squeeze juice into mouth, throw bits in, on a spoon, get her to bite a bit
Use some weird fruit that the children may not have seen before

Thank you, you have really helped.
Wow! What a lot of fruit God made. So many different colours. So many different flavours, and textures. God was so kind to us making so much fruit.

Take off blind fold



<p>Do you know how God made all those fruit? God just spoke and it happened! Shall we try it?</p>	<p>Hold out your empty hand.</p>
<p>God just said "orange", and there is was.</p>	<p>Pause and look at hand</p>
<p>We can't do it. When we speak, food doesn't just get made.</p>	
<p>But when God speaks, an orange is made. So next time you go shopping, just remember that God made everything you see just by <u>speaking</u>.</p>	<p>Take orange out of trolley.</p>
	<p>Sing - Who's the King of the Jungle? or My God is so Big!</p>



Top Tips

- Craft idea: something edible, e.g. decorate a biscuit
