Story	Actions
We have been hearing this term that God made everything out of nothing. God made everything just by speaking.	
Use previous visuals to explain what God has already made... <u>Visual 1</u> First we found out that God made the land. All that you can see- God made it. Then we found out that God made all the plants and trees. If you can eat it, or chew it, then God made it. <u>Visual 2</u> And made the sea and the sky. If you can swim and you can fly in a plane and you can wave your hands then God made it all. <u>Visual 3</u> And last week we found out that God made the sun and the moon and all the stars. So we can see during the day, and at night	Place on hills Place on tree Place on sea and clouds
Who here loves swimming? But do you know who the best swimmer in the whole world is? THE FISH! Today we're going to find out that God made fish, and he made them amazing.	
Look at the shiny scales on the fish, so smooth and so beautiful Look how their tails can swish side to side Look at the gills, they can breathe through these	Show dead fish
God made this fish very clever. This fish lies flat on the bottom of the sea, and when a little fish swims by, it jumps up and ... GULP. Both its eyes are on the same side, so they can see fish swimming by even when they're lying on the bottom.	Show dead flat fish (plaice or sole)
