God made the WORLD	Genesis 1:6-10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A completely clear board</li> <li>• A Tambourine</li> <li>• 5 pieces of material to stick up: Black, white, light blue for sky, light blue for water and green/brown for land.</li> </ul>
God made FRUIT and VEGETABLES	Genesis 1:11-13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Board created at "God made the world"</li> <li>• Helper</li> <li>• Blindfold</li> <li>• Kids trolley full of food</li> <li>• Visual with splodges of lots of different colours</li> </ul>
God made SUN, MOON & STARS	Genesis 1:14-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a large screen with the story so far set up already- land, sea, sky, trees, plants</li> <li>• Sun</li> <li>• Moon</li> <li>• Stars</li> </ul>
God made FISH	Genesis 1:21	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Previous visuals from the creation series</li> <li>• Dead fish</li> <li>• Dead plaice or sole</li> </ul>
God made ANIMALS	Genesis 1:25	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Animal puppets in a bag</li> </ul>
God made PEOPLE	Genesis 1:26-31	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Apple</li> <li>• A tub of sand</li> <li>• A jug of water and a cup</li> <li>• A lamp or a torch</li> <li>• Fish</li> <li>• A doll or action man figure</li> <li>• A helper under a sheet</li> </ul>

Jesus turns water into wine	John 2:1-11	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Red food colouring</li> <li>• Glass jug full of water</li> <li>• Clear drinking glass</li> </ul>
Feeding the 5000	Mark 6:30-44	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fish</li> <li>• Bread rolls</li> <li>• Basket or bucket</li> </ul>
Jesus made the lame walk	Mark 2:1-11	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chair</li> <li>• Doll or action figure man</li> </ul>
Jesus made a blind man see	John 9:1-12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mud face pack in a cup</li> <li>• Damp cloth</li> <li>• Helper</li> </ul>
Jesus made a deaf man hear	Mark 7:31-37	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a whole bunch of things that make different sounds: whistles, drums, tambourines, shakers</li> <li>• helper to sit on a stool pretending to be deaf and dumb</li> </ul>
