<p>This term we're hearing all about how God made everything, just by speaking.</p>	
<p>We've seen that God made everything. He made:</p> <p>He made fruit and veg; all that we eat</p> <p>All the ground we tread on, all the countries of the world</p> <p>All the water in the world, all the lakes and all the oceans.</p> <p>God made the sun, moon and the stars.</p> <p>We found out that God made fish as well.</p>	<p>Hold up each of the following: Apple</p> <p>A tub of sand. Take out a handful.</p> <p>A jug of water Pour some into a cup from a great height!</p> <p>Bright light Turn it on. Shine in eyes. Fish</p>
<p>What else did he make? Now we get to the best bit. In fact it's the bit that God was most pleased with.</p>	

<p>Look what I've got!</p>	<p>Hold up a doll, an action man and perhaps another toy "person"</p>
<p>Someone made these to look like people. Aren't they great!</p> <p>Aren't these great!</p>	<p>Explain why these models are so good:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shiny hair • Eyes that look real • Lips that are the right colour • Arms and legs that move. • Sounds they make.
<p>But do you know, these are nowhere near as good as <u>real</u> people.</p>	<p>Have a person under a sheet, standing statue still, and now reveal them!</p>
<p>Look how God made us! We're amazing.</p>	<p>Point at body parts.</p>
<p>God made us all different and all amazing. God made each of you special</p>	
<p>And look how God made us so we can do things. Dolls can just move their arms but look what we can do!</p>	<p>Get the person to jump, run on the spot, hop, star jumps, wave.</p>
<p>And do you know he made each of us just by speaking. The Bible says that we are the most wonderful, amazing things that God made. I think the Bible is right.</p>	
<p>We are amazing because God is amazing, and he made each one of us.</p>	

Sing – My God is so big, so strong and so mighty.
